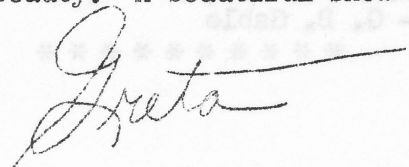
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Other older favorites are Blue Sapphire, Black Taffeta, Violet Harmony, The Citadel, Desert Song, Lady Rogers, Tranquility, Grand Teton, First Violet, Lynn Hall, Inca Chief, Ammadine, Rosy Veil, and June Meredith.

Among the newer introductions Court Ballet, Lilac Festival, Rainbow Gold, Polka Time, Crinkled Beauty, Celestial Snow, Sparkling Waters, Striped Butterfly, Chinese Coral, Pompano Peach, Rococo, Kahihi, Edinite, Symphony, Brightside, and After Dark have grown well in my garden and elsewhere.

These favorites of mine are not only champions on the show table but perform equally well in the garden.

LABELS

Of all the tools I use in my garden I find my Dymo machine is the most useful. It automatically prints my name tags in very legible type on plastic tape with adhesive backing. When these are attached to my aluminum labels they withstand our severe Minnesota seasons.

Dymo is as easy to use as a dial telephone. It is possible to take it to the garden and make labels as needed.

I noticed all labels in the tour gardens of Tennessee and Mississippi at the National Convention were made with it. Our labels were purchased from the Youth Opportunity advertized in the AIS Bulletin.
