### SUMMER SPECIAL

The big event of the summer for Twin City Iris Society is the AUCTION, to be held this year on August 11, at Guaranty State Bank, starting at 5:30 P.M. Members are asked to bring their iris donations early enough to get them on display before the crowds come. If rhizomes cannot be brought early the day of the auction, they may be delivered to the auction chairman, Mr. Urban Ipsen, a day or two before.

The name and color of the iris should be marked on the leaves, and good old varieties that are still popular are preferred to the old ones that have not lasted in popularity.

WHO'S WHO IN TCIS

Mrs. Norman Bucholdt's garden and interests were called to our attention when she read the article in April about flowers of the Holy Land. Mrs. Bucholdt has slides of about 135 different plants and trees from the Holy Land. She also has some of them growing in her yard: dandelion (haven't we all?), bitter herb, apricot, apple, aloes, burning bush, flowering almond, pink rock rose, cyclamen, Venice looking glass (a sweeping mass of deep purple), Star of Bethlehem--to name a few. Mrs. Bucholdt has slides of roses, birds, and wild flowers, too. She has been a member of the Twin City Iris Society since the first year the show was at the Lutheran Brotherhood Building, when she won a prize on Snow Flurry. The reason we don't see Mrs. Bucholdt at many meetings is that she works nights as a practical nurse at a rest home.

Mr. Urban Ipsen, who is chairman of the auction and has been chairman of the auction for several years, says he's driving for a princess or a queen in the show this year. He's tired of bronze medals. The Ipsens have been members of the Iris Society since about 1953. They bought their house from Bud Foss, who left them some of his iris, and that's how their interest began. Mr. Ipsen has been show chairman four years, was president in 1960, and has served on the Board of Directors. Other hobbies include rock hunting, cutting, and polishing (He's been a member of the Minnesota Mineral Club longer than TCIS.), and fishing. Old favorite iris are more likely to be kept in the Ipsen garden than some of the new ones after a fair trial.

Dr. Reuben David, second vice president of the society this year, is mainly interested in hybridizing, so does not keep many named varieties of iris in his garden. He has been a member of TCIS about six years and hybridizing about three years. His garden holds about two thousand iris this year. Another of his hobbies is hybridizing bees, which he has been doing since he was about twelve years old. Raising bees used to be a business for him, for that's how he put himself through college. Now that bee raising is a hobby, he has only about forty swarms on his acreage at Maple Plain instead of the five hundred he used to have. Money from the twenty-four tons of honey last year will be used for a trip to Europe the first of August. Iris became a hobby because it is too hard for Dr. David, who is a general practitioner in Hopkins, to get away to go fishing. He has a telephone extension for the garden. Minnesota has been Dr. David's home since 1951.

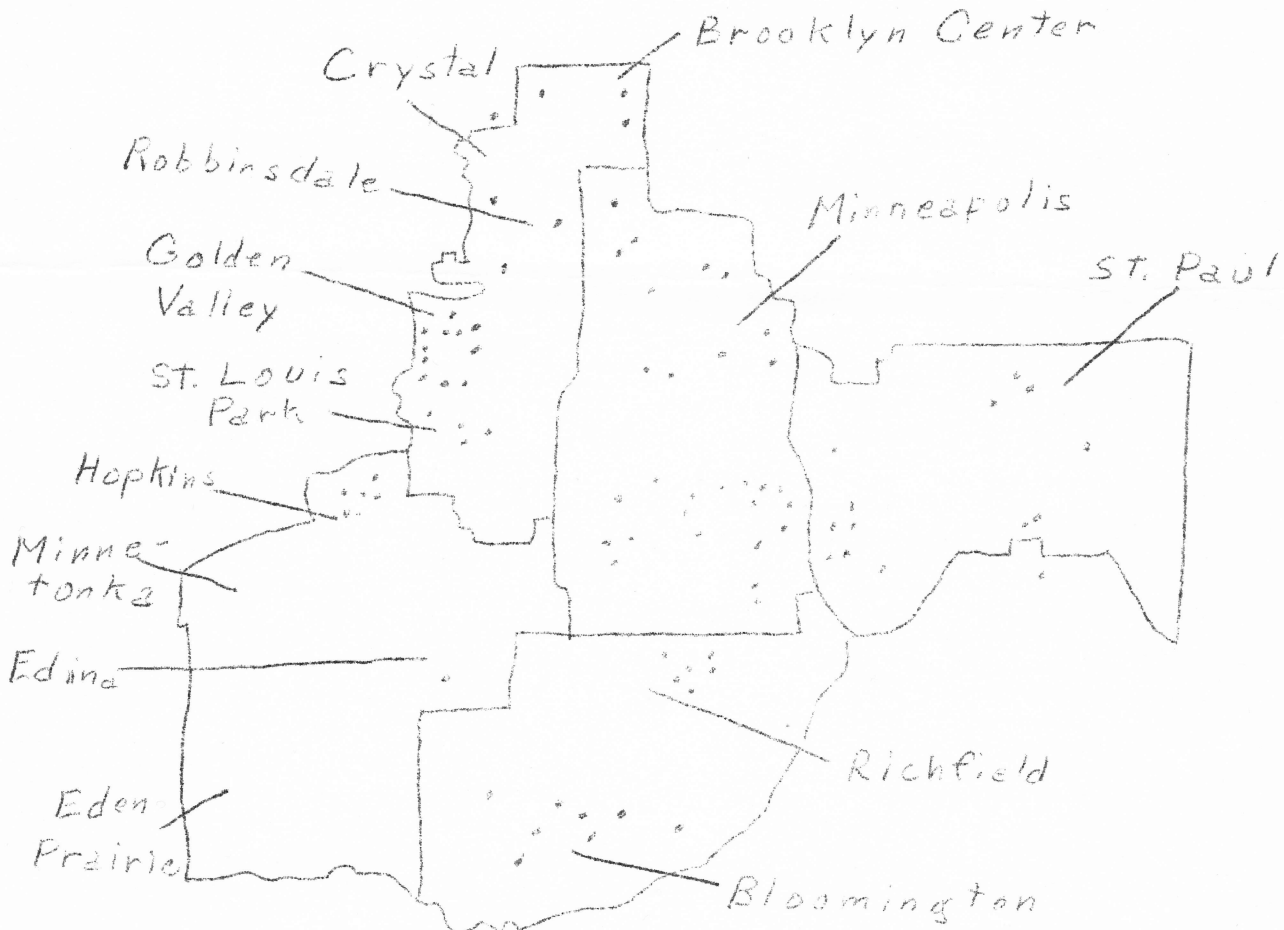
