In an effort to help our members to better understand and evaluate catalog and bulletin descriptions of iris, we have selected a few of the more commonly used expressions, with our interpretations of their meaning:

Refined and Delicate; wishy-washy type, no zip. Medium sized; this means a small flower. Average size; this also means a small flower. Not large but ...; same as above. Nice; hybridizer is present or listening. Nice but ...; hybridizer is not within earshot. Coarse or unrefined; This is a large, bright gay flower and everyone likes it.

Does not tuck; this means it has all the other faults except this one.

Immense flowers; this merely means the flower is too large for the size of the stem so it is necessary to grow it on a trellis like a morning glory.

34 inches tall; this of course was measured from the tip of the longest root to about two inched above the blossom 32 inches tall; Oh, brother !!!!!

Great landscape variety; means they got stuck with it and are try-ing to get something back before they pitch it out.

As this is our most important meeting of the year your presence is especially requested. We can promise you a most enjoyable eveningwith good food and excellent company.

Here are a few of the very very new irises that we saw for the first time this year and that we thought were especially impressive:

Evensong: This Mohr hybrid is very large and tall. The color is lavender. Like most other Mohr hybrids, the foliage dies back during the summer months.

Helen Collingwood: Light lawender standards and bright violet purple falls.

This is in the same color class as Amigo but it is a far superior flower.

Limelight: A greenish yellow iris that is nicely frilled on both standards and falls. This variety is truly outstanding.

Tosca: A ruffled lavender blue with very heavy substance and excellent form. We liked this new blue as well as anything we saw this year.

Tranquillity: 'e have seen nearly all of the white iris in commerce and this in our opinion is the best. The color is a milk white. It is about 40 inches tall with very heavy substance and exceptionally long blooming in habit.

The 1953 Hardiness and Performnce report is included as a part of this bulletin. It is regrettable that there weren't more of the reports returned but nevertheless we feel it will be informative and at least a step in the right direction. To those of you who co-operated, our most sincere thanks.

Cleaning up the dead leaves and debris in and around your iris clumps at this time will be a great help in controlling a possible borer infestation in your garden next spring. Do not put this litter on your compost heap as it is one of the major egg depositories of the borer moth.

It is our belief that a winter cover is very necessary for this particular climate. We generally cover AFTER the ground is frozen and we always remove the cover as soon as it is free of ice in the spring. Recommended covers are marsh hay, evergreen boughs, excelsior or tree leaves. Do not use pulpy refuse from the vegetable garden as it has a tendency to mildew and become mouldy.

The Second Annual Performance and Hardiness Poll of the

THIN CITY IRIS SOCIETY

To begin with we would like to thank those of you who cooperated with us in compiling the information listed below. Frankly we were disappointed in the small percentage of replies we received, as a result the information gleaned on about half the varieties listed is quite vague and very inconclusive. However there are some varieties that were given an almost thorough analysis that should prove quite interesting to everyone.

You will recall we asked you to grade the various parts of the queries with either en "A" (good), a "B" (fair) or a "C" (poor), In breaking down the reports submitted we credited all "A" reports with 10 points, all "B" reports with 8 points and all "C" reports with 0 points. By adding the points earned by the number of reports we obtained a number, this number was placed in the space provided for for each of the six categories of the varieties used. As an example Argus Pheasant received the following rating:

Hardiness; 7 As 3 D n O Cs 7 As equal 70 pts , 3 Bs equal 24 pts 70 plus 24 equal 94 e 19 or 9.4 pts.

Increase; 6 A's or 60 points, 3 B's or 24 points 1 C or 0 points. 60 plus 24 plus 0 equals 84 divided by 10 or 8.4 points.

Thoming Habits: 6 A's or 60 pts, 3 B's or 24 points 0 C's. 60 plus 24 agual 84 divided by 9 or 9.3 points.

Stalk: 9 A's or 90 points, 1 B or 8 points. 90 plus 6 equal 98 divided by 10 or 9.8 total points. etc. etc.

To simplify matters we then dropped the decimal point. In evaluating the numbers we considered a score of 91 to 100 as being excellent; 81 to 90 as good; 71 to 80 as fair; 61 to 70 as poor and below 60 as a failure. There less than five reports were received on any one variety we did not evaluate the information as we felt it would not be conclusive.

This then is our second ennual hardiness and performence poll.
